

General Information

- All games are at Lysander Town park.
- Saturdays 8AM-12PM.
- If cancellation is needed, notification will be sent out via email and text message.
- Multiple fields in use, check in at the BYSA shed upon arrival to confirm assignment

- Referee Schedules are on the website
- Check in at BYSA Shed before your First assigned game to get your Auto-Whistle (and jersey if needed)
- Stop at BYSA Shed after your last game to cash out
- Make sure to leave a cell phone number just in case



General Rules/Expectations

- Check all players for shin guards AND cleats before the game
 - If they do not have them, they can not play
 - Used cleats are available at the BYSA shed for anyone to use
- Jewelry should not be worn during games
- Make sure you are keeping track of time
 - Do not stop clock unless someone falls to the ground and seems injured
 - Give Coaches a heads up when halfway through a quarter
- Goalie must have a different color on than the rest of the team (pinnie)
- Use the whistle! Make sure it is loud enough for everyone to hear
- Move around the field, do not stay in one spot
- Parents are being asked to sit on the opposite side of the field from the players; we've asked coaches to enforce this

General Rules/Expectations (Cont'd)

- BYSA is a Zero Tolerance Organization
 - No Bullying
 - No "trash talk"
- Players
 - Blow the Whistle/Stop play if this occurs
 - Give warning to player and notify their Coach
- Coaches
 - They are aware of the rules and shall provide assistance with players
 - If Coach is the offender, let a BYSA Board member know as soon as possible
- Parents Let a BYSA Board Member know as soon as possible if there are issues with Parents and it becomes disruptive

<u>U5 and U6</u>

- Help the kids learn to recognize the whistle and what it means
- Coaches can be on the field
- 4 Players at a time on the field
- 10-minute quarters
- Ball is brought to center after a goal. Pass (backwards) to your teammate before moving forward
- Throw-Ins need to be correct help guild the kids (they get 3 attempts)
 - Thrower must be completely out of bounds
 - 2 feet on the ground
 - Ball fully behind throwers head
- Calls
 - Hand balls
 - Lines (in/out)
 - Any Rough Play that could potentially cause injury
 - Corner Kicks/Goal Kicks
- No heading the ball

<u>U8</u>

- Coaches can be on the field
- 5 Players on the field at a Time
- Goalie in net
- 12-minute quarters
- Ball is brought to center after a goal. Pass (backwards) to your teammate before moving forward
- No direct kicks
- Throw-Ins need to be correct help guild the kids (they get 3 attempts)
 - Thrower must be completely out of bounds
 - 2 feet on the ground
 - Ball fully behind throwers head
- Calls
 - Hand balls
 - Lines (in/out)
 - Any Rough Play that could potentially cause injury
 - Corner Kicks/Goal Kicks
- No heading the ball

U11

- Two Refs assigned to all games (Field Ref and Line Ref)
- No Coaches allowed on the field
- 7 Players on the Field
- Goalie in Net
- 15-minute quarters
- No heading the ball
- No direct kicks

- Goalie steps out of box and holds the ball, call it as Handball and other team gets an Indirect Kick
- Calls
 - Offsides
 - Hand Balls
 - Lines (in/out)
 - Corner Kicks
 - Goal Kicks
 - Fouls/Rough Play

U14

- Two Refs assigned to all games (Field Ref and Line Ref)
- No Coaches allowed on the field
- 7 players on the field
- Goalie in Net
- Direct Kicks Allowed
- Heading the ball is permitted

- Goalie steps out of box and holds the ball, call it as Handball and other team gets an Indirect Kick
- Calls
 - Offsides
 - Hand Balls
 - Lines (in/out)
 - Corner Kicks
 - Goal Kicks
 - Fouls/Rough Play
